

THE POLICY LAW OFF BOSNIA I HERZEGOVINA

("Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina", No. 57/04, 51/06 i 76/06)

The equipment put in free trade, / and which is based on foreign investments, except travelling motor vehicles, automats for entertainment and lottery is exempted from duty.

The equipment of military and police forces of Entities and prisons of Entities, and which is completely financed by donators, which is put in free trade, is exempted from duty.

The equipment for the renewal and reconstruction projects in BiH which is put in free trade is exempted from duty, if the project is:

- approved by the Council of Ministers or the Entities Governments;
- completely financed by donators or financed by International Development Banks.

The Council of Ministers prescribes more detailed regulations about Resolution enactment procedure which approves exemption from duty from subsection 1., 2., 3., i 4. article 162./

/household effects for equipping secondary domicile, capital equipment and other equipment imported based on the principle of transfer of the activity from abroad into BiH,

What is exempted from duty / are victims of accidents, goods for charity or humanitarian organisations, goods assigned to blind persons needs, goods assigned to other handicaped persons, passenger vehicles imported by invalid persons, products of insignificant value which accepts periodically in letters and postal packages, various documents and products, goods imported based on trade-promotional principles, products used or consumed on trade fairs or other similar events, consignments sent to organizations and which protect copyrights or rigts of industrial and comercial patent, goods imported with purpose to research the analysis or of testing, high decorations, awards and gifts, educational, scientific and cultural materials, scientific instruments and machines, laboratory animals and biologic and chemical matters assigned to research, therapeutical substances of human origin and reagents for determining blood types and types of tissues, pharmaceutical products used on international sport events, medicines for personal use, goods imported on the occasion of weedings, coffins with bodies and urns with ashes of deceased persons and decorations that go along.

In accordance with international conventions and agreements custom exemptions can be given.

Modifications and additions of the Tariff Policy Law are gazetted in "Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina ", No. 76/06 dated September, 25th 2006, and came into force on October 03. 2006.
